

2020 GSA Art Prize

University of Melbourne graduate students submit a work of art to GSA for the chance to win cash prizes.

Terms and conditions of entry

1. By entering this competition, you agree to these Terms and Conditions:
2. The 2020 GSA Art Prize is an annual competition restricted to currently enrolled University of Melbourne graduate students.
3. There will be four cash prizes awarded: \$750 (First place), \$500 (Second place), \$250 (Third place), \$150 (a “People’s Choice” popular vote winner).
4. The People’s Choice popular vote winner is based on an aggregate vote score.
5. Only one entry per student is accepted.
6. The entrant must warrant that they are the creator of this work, and it was created in the last 12 months.
7. Entries will be accepted between 9am on 28th September and 12pm on the 19th October. GSA will not accept late or misdirected entries.
8. When submitting artwork, students must complete the GSA Art Prize Entry Form and provide necessary documentation.
9. The decision regarding the winning entries is final; no correspondence will be entered into.
10. Only digital entries can be accepted, submitted through the GSA Art Prize entry Form.
11. Entry Requirements:
 - a) Your entry must be digital. This can be digital art, photographs or photographs of a physical piece of work (e.g. a photo of a painting or sculpture)
 - b) No animations or videos will be accepted
 - c) Minimum dimensions 1200 x 1800 px
 - d) Minimum quality 300dpi
 - e) Metadata must be removed before submission
12. Entries considered to be offensive or that do not comply with the values of GSA may be rejected.
13. Copyright remains with the entrant; however, by participating in the GSA Art Prize, the entrant grants the following rights to GSA:
 - a) Permission to display all entries (or part thereof) and publicise all entries (or part thereof) on its website, or in other websites and locations and for promotional purposes.
 - b) Grant GSA a perpetual and non-exclusive license to use footage and photographs, for non-commercial purposes, in all media worldwide.
14. GSA reserves the right to exclude an entry or withdraw a prize in the event of an entrant being unable to satisfy the entry requirements or these Terms and Conditions.
